

Pakistani Students In Palestine Refuse To Come Back, Say Palestine Still Safer Than Pakistan



he families of hundreds of Pakistani students stuck in Palestine following the Israel retaliation to Hamas attack are urging their government to help bring them home. However, a majority of these students aren't willing to come back.

Speaking to The Fauxy, a Pakistani student stranded in Palestine said "It's all missile dropping and bombing happening here, it feels like home. Despite a full fledged war we feel safer here than in Pakistan".

Media reports say more than 200 students have been stuck in Palestine and Gaza since the Israel retaliation after Hamas attack.

"We thought of evacuation process but when the students didn't show willingness to come back we took another 500 students and dropped them in Palestine." said Pakistan External Affair Minister Shah Mehmood Qureshi.

"It's okay if these students feel safer in palestine than in Pakistan, we have 200 less people to feed" said Pakistan PM in a press conference.

n Wednesday, Russian forces bombarded scores of towns in Ukraine as Russian President Vladimir Putin was reportedly upset with the NATO song

of RRR being awarded Oscar. Earlier Putin had said that he is open to negotiations, a stance Washington has dismissed as posturing because of continued Russian attacks.

Russia on Wednesday launched more than 10 rocket attacks on the Kupiansk district in the Kharkiv region, confirmed Ukraine's top military command.

Russia's ambassador in United States has asked to retract its decision of awarding NATO song an Oscar. Speaking to The Fauxy, Russia's ambassador said "We don't have problem with RRR movie winning Oscar but jury could have chosen a different song. Choosing NATO for Oscar is a deliberate attempt to provoke Russia".

United States President, Joe Biden replied to Russia's demand and said "The truth is lies What's clear, and I mean this [from] the bottom of my heart, NATO NATO.."

Wrestling Federation Chief Brij Bhushan Sharan Singh identifies as woman. CJI baffled.

Justice of India
DY
Chandrachud

ordered the Delhi Police to file an FIR on the basis of the complaints lodged by the wrestlers protesting at Jantar Mantar. Several prominent wrestlers have been protesting at Delhi's Jantar Mantar seeking action against Wrestling Federation of India (WFI) president Brij Bhushan Sharan Singh for alleged sexual harassment of players.

However, the wrestling protest took an interesting turn when Wrestling Federation Chief Brij Bhushan Singh identified himself as a woman and filed a counter FIR against the wrestlers. Reportedly, Brij Bhushan Singh in his complaint called

himself a gender-fluid, who currently identifies himself as woman.

Upon asking how it happened all of a sudden, when there are allegations against you, Brij Bhushan Singh said "the concept of gender is complex and the definition of a biological man and a biological woman is not restricted to a person's genitals."

Brij Bhushan further added "Many women wrestlers look more masculine than men, does it make them men? similarly I may look like a man but I can be a woman, and wrestlers can harass me".



n Monday, the rupee hit a new all-time low

n Monday, the rupee hit a new all-time low against the dollar, plunging well past 81.50 per dollar as the dollar rose sharply to multi-year highs against most major currencies on fears of a global recession from the rising borrowing rates worldwide.

Opposition parties accused the government and Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman of mishandling the situation. The Modi-led BJP government assured the people that it is taking several measures to avoid further slip of the Rupee against the dollar. In one such step, the government is bringing an anti-conversion bill in the winter session of the parliament.

Reportedly, the government is in the final stage of drafting the anti-conversion bill, which will be presented in the winter session of the parliament. As per the draft, government will make the Rupee to Dollar conversion void and the value of the rupee will be measured only in the currency which is weaker than Rupee.



Govt to bring Anti-Conversion Law amidst weakening Rupee against Dollar


Bangalesh's Taka, Pakistan's PKR and SriLanka's LKR are the top contenders in the list.

It could be political power too"

This isn't a standalone case of investors going crazy for their favourite company shares, earlier, a man bought the share of the Pharma company instead of buying the medicines and later succumbed to his investments.





India promotes racism by being the bright spot in the global economy: Economic Experts

ritic of Govt economic policies, former Reserve Bank of India (RBI) Governor Raghuram Rajan

on Saturday called Indian Govt economic policies discriminatory. Raghuram Rajan's statement came after International Monetary Fund (IMF) said that India will be a bright spot in global economy in 2023.

Lauding India's strong macroeconomic fundamentals, IMF said that India is in a better position to deal with the global headwinds.

However, economists in India called it a bad sign as India is promoting racism by being bright spot and not dark spot. Economists said that India's economic policies are against the Black Lives Matter movement.

Earlier, economic expert had said that India will be cornered if it doesn't get hit by recession like rest of the world.

Reportedly, India is likely to incorporate some points in the upcoming Budget 2023 to avoid being a bright spot. he makers of the controversial 'The Kerala Story' are yet again in controversy after ISIS expressed its disapproval




RBI says Neeraj Chopra's Gold reserve helped in preventing rupee from falling to record low
